I/We understand that the Registration Fee is due upon submittal of this application. A Registration Fee is due each school year and for each child you are enrolling. We accept cash or checks we do not accept credit cards.

The Registration Fee is non-refundable unless, the child is not being granted admission to the school due to a waiting list or low enrollment: (Please initial one)

- 2019 Full Day Summer Program & 2019-2020 School Year \$85 Per Child
- 2019 Full Day Summer Program \$35 Per Child (Must be currently enrolled in the CDC)
 - If you enroll after April 12, 2019 your Summer Program Registration Fee will be \$50.
- 2019-2020 School Year Only \$50 Per Child

Completed Registration Form, Registration Fee and a current copy of your child's latest Immunization Record must be submitted for your application to be processed. If you are missing any of the required forms, information or fees your Registration Form will not be processed until it is submitted. (Immunization Record is only required with registration if your child is new to our center.)

Family of Christ Child Development Center does not guarantee admission to any applicant. It is the mission of Family of Christ to provide a quality Christian education to all of its students. Family of Christ recognizes that there may be applicants for admission whose background and circumstances are such that the applicants would require extraordinary attention and/or resources and that their admission would therefore disproportionately reduce the attention and resources available to other students. Family of Christ also recognizes that, from time to time, there may be an applicant whose background suggests that he/she may pose a potential risk to other students. Family of Christ must consider the best interest of its student body as a whole and for that reason it is the policy of Family of Christ not to accept such applicants. Exceptions to this policy may only be made by the Board of Education for the Child Development Center.
