


Building Community through Gods Gifts

This class is for both Jr. High (at times) and High School, as well as parents! We've been averaging 15 people each week in January. Come join us!


Jeremy is using a curriculum called **Conversation Kits**, put out by a local Colorado Springs ministry called Axis. In their own words:


In February, we went through there 4-week class on Social Media. Here's the schedule for the rest of the Spring.
