Pastor's Page

As a child, not many things brought wonder and excitement quite like Christmas did. From a child's perspective, there are great decorations like the shiny, colorful lights and the majestic tree covered in ornaments. There were usually a few traditions like putting out reindeer food and cookies for Santa. It all culminated in a sleepless night as I wondered what might be under the tree. I hoped for the perfect gift! I was hoping for a cool action figure.

As an adult, I wonder how much wonder and excitement is associated with Christmas these days. Adults tend to look at this time of the year as an endless string of weekend commitments, purchasing gifts, and racking up debt. There are family members to visit and pictures to be taken. We hope for a stress-free holiday.

What is missing in those first two paragraphs is anything about our faith and how Christmas is defined by the perfect gift of love: Our Lord Jesus! Early Christians thought of the Trinity as being connected to the big three Church celebrations: Jesus is celebrated at Easter, the Holy Spirit is celebrated at Pentecost, and God the Father is celebrated at Christmas.



Over the years, we focus so much on the baby in the manger. And rightly so! But let us not forget that Christ is a gift from the Father!

"For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this." Isaiah 9:6-7

God knows exactly what we really need: Love and forgiveness. No returns are needed, no exchanges are made. Christmas is another way God proclaims to His creation that He LOVES us. My prayer for you this December is to not worry about the perfect gift and providing the perfect experience for everyone else: Enjoy and celebrate the perfect gift already given!
