January - Military Care Packages: We will be making up some care packages to send to our deployed troops, including one that worships here at FOC! If you are interested in helping, please drop any of the items listed in the bin marked "Military Care Packages." **Items Needed:** Quick protein, Coffee, Powdered drink mix, Pretzels, Candy, Hand sanitizer, Shampoo, Wipes, Soap, Toothpaste, Beef jerky, Cheez-its, Healthy snacks, Dried fruit, Words of encouragement, Reading materials (including magazines), Homemade goodies in an airtight container, Batteries, Writing materials (including stamps so your service member can write you back.)

January 12 - 26 - Welcome Babies Drive in support of Life Network: This Drive is a congregation-wide opportunity to collect baby items for Life Network's pregnancy center in Colorado Springs. Over the past year, this wonderful organization has saved 259 babies, inspired 86 decisions for Christ, and influenced 89% of their ultrasound patients to choose life! Stephen Ministry

The Stephen Ministry at Family of Christ invites you to gain new insights to such issues as *Caring for the Hospitalized* and *Ministering to the Dying and Their Family and Friends* by joining our Stephen Ministry Team during their monthly Continuing Education Program! FOC is entering our 4th year with 13 trained and Commissioned Stephen Ministers currently supporting 5 congregation members. This ministry has developed a goal to be more transparent, relevant, and helpful to our Congregation and our Spiritual Leaders, while continuing to ensure confidentiality for our Care Receivers and addressing recurring issues within FOC.

Our Stephen Ministers have one Supervisory Session monthly, but in 2020 YOU may attend/audit and/or participate in their monthly Open Training Sessions. As this announcement illustrates, our Stephen Ministry will let you know the subject, time, date, and location for each event: **they do ask that you let them know at least one week in advance that you wish to participate**.

The team will provide you an outline for each session, and you will be able to participate in the discussions and diverse role-playing segments of each lesson. We expect this to inspire confidence in our Stephen Ministry program, as well as to better communicate how YOU can help Pastor Mark, the Elders, and our Stephen Ministers find hurting congregation members, family, and friends in the community who can benefit from having someone dedicated to walking alongside them during stressful and even life-changing crises.

Open Training Sessions:

This month they will deal with an on-going issue in FOC, *Caring for the Hospitalized*, on Sunday, January 26, 11:30 am to 1:30 pm in the *Kitchen*.

Similarly, they will address *Ministry to the Dying and Their Family and Friends*, on Sunday, February 23, from 11:30 am – to 1:30 pm, in the *Kitchen*.

Children's Ministry

To celebrate the New Year in Children's Ministry, we are starting a new curriculum called GROW! We believe that this change will be the best for our children here at Family of Christ, as well as the parents and volunteers involved in the ministry.

The new curriculum will provide a new series each month, which will keep kids excited about what they are learning. This month, we we're beginning a series called **Blast Off**, which is a 4-week series on spiritual habits. If you're a grown up and you've been following Jesus for a while, you've probably figured out a few ways to grow spiritually. However, the kids you're currently parenting or leading in this ministry will probably need some guidance in this area. So what does spiritual growth look like for a kid? To help children grow spiritually, we will teach them to spend time with God, **spend time with others, use their gifts, and share their story.**
