And how have we honored our philosophy? Through teaching centers based on weekly themes. The centers in each room include Science, Math, Dramatic Play, Art, Reading, Blocks and Writing Center. Each week new activities are provided in the various classroom centers for the children to explore during learning center time.

All classes will follow a daily routine that allows for flexibility to meet the children's needs. The daily routine includes Center Time, Art, Group Time, Snack, Gym/Outdoor Play, Music and Jesus Time. Our goal is to adequately prepare your child for Kindergarten and continued success in school.
