

Monthly Academic Goals

Pre-K

At *Family of Christ Child Development Center*, we engage the Pre-Kindergartner in hands-on learning combined with teacher directed activities. A list of *Monthly Academic Goals* will be sent home at the beginning of each month. Your child will be exposed to these goals, and since we expect our students to develop at different paces, our intention is to make them feel proud of all their accomplishments.

Family of Christ Pre-K Curriculum is divided into 5 main components. They are:

Character Building: This program is designed to encourage positive social and emotional development. Each month one virtue will be discussed and practiced. There will be one Bible verse to compliment each virtue.

Math: Students will be exposed to math experiences that are broader than numerals and counting. Pre-K Math will expose students to patterning, positioning, graphing, matching, sorting, comparing and problem solving. Students will experience daily music activities as an integral part of early Math.

God's Wonderful World (Science & Social Studies): Students will participate in Science experiments and use tools to observe, predict and discover God's wonderful world. Students will be exposed to different countries and a variety of biomes in our world.

Early Literacy: Through songs and creative activities, students will be exposed to early reading and writing skills, along with letter recognition and phonemic awareness. Students will experience early literacy through dictation, writing practice, story sequencing, flannel stories and a variety of Circle Time activities.

Bible Time: Daily Bible Time will give students an opportunity to hone their listening skills and learn about God's Word. Weekly Bible themes will be presented in creative lessons and songs, and encourage students to recall facts and extend their attention spans.
